10. 科目内容・ 授業計画	<p>This course is designed to both explore the concept of global citizenship, and empower students to become leaders in their own community. This course is divided into three parts. During the first part of the class, we will explore the idea of global citizenship and what it means to be a citizen. Readings will pose questions about the concept of citizenship, identity and nationalism, and the power of information/media. Second, we will discuss leadership, systems thinking and potential solutions to wicked problems. This part of the course will help students think about empathy, emotional intelligence and leadership for success in a fast-paced world.
