10. 科目内容・ 授業計画	<p>Understanding and appreciating cultural differences and ensuring diversity in society are crucial for the realisation of SDGs. Additionally, understanding Japanese culture is essential not only for foreign students but also for Japanese students. This course aims to foster sensibility and creativity by exploring the culture of Japan, the relationship with Asian and Western countries throughout the centuries, and the cultural expressions and forms born within the specific social context of the different historical periods. We learn about the interactions between native Japanese culture and foreign cultures, as expressed in mythology, performing arts, painting, Buddhist art, crafts, and architecture, focusing also on Japanese traditional and religious rites and their role in contemporary society. How did the Japanese adopt foreign cultures and create new cultural forms? How has Japanese culture been accepted and recognized in the world? By understanding Japanese culture from the perspective of its relation to the outside world, students gain a broad and full global perspective.</p> <p>This course is built from reading assignments and discussions based on them. The lecturer selects and distributes reading and visual materials. Each group summarizes the content of their assignment and posits questions for discussion in groups or by the whole class. The instructor explains the material as needed. The course implements project-based learning (PBL). Students select for their individual projects a topic related to Japanese culture, conduct a comprehensive research, preferably from a comparative perspective, and prepare the required PBL assignments. The main part of the assessment is based on this PBL (40%).</p>
