10. 科目内容· 授業計画	As defined by the Ancient Greek philosopher Aristotle, human beings are "social animals." We rely on cooperation to survive and thrive. Depending on the specific historical context, each society has developed its own culture. For example, the notions of life and death differ greatly from culture to culture. There are also significant cultural differences in mundane daily activities such as eating habits, clothing, communication, and so on.  The purpose of this course is to comprehend the characteristics of different cultures through comparison. We will particularly focus on food culture, festivals, traditional and religious rites, and performance culture. Students will use their language skills, acquired in practical English, to read, view and interpret textual and visual materials in English, and discuss their possible interpretations. Through this process, students will gain the ability to understand and value cultural differences, to communicate effectively with people from different cultural and social backgrounds, and thus will broaden their viewpoint.  This course is built from reading assignments and discussions based on them. The lecturer selects and distributes reading and visual materials. Each group summarizes the content of their assignment and posits questions for discussion in groups or by the whole class. The instructor explains the material as needed. The course implements project-based learning (PBL). Groups are assigned a project related to the course content and each individual member is expected to contribute as they are able, in cooperation with the others. The main part of the assessment (40%) is based on this group work (PBL), which requires submission of written report, following designated
